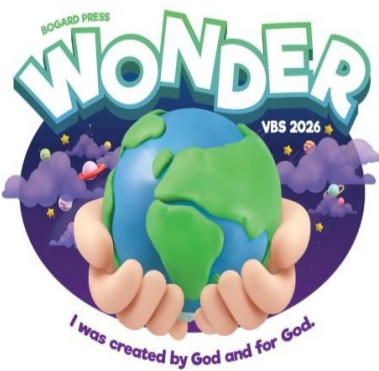

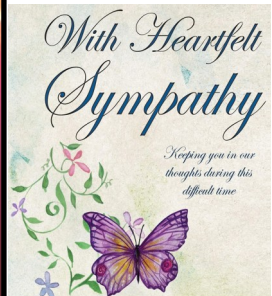

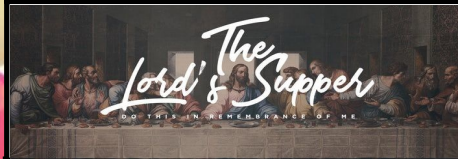
TERRY'S TIDBITS
