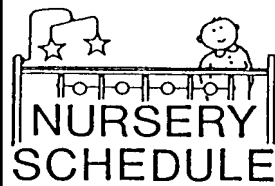

Psalm 150 is a universal call to worship that addresses all of creation, heaven and earth alike, and even meanders through the congregation and choir as it invokes worship of the Creator.

Perhaps Psalm 150 was actually written as a concluding statement, a grand finale to the symphony of praise of this marvelous book, with a pounding, insistent theme: "Praise the Lord!"

As a musician, I love the sound of a choir singing in-tune. There's something incredibly right when the subtleties of intonation are mastered. And there's something terribly jarring and hindering when they are not. I have learned to recognize out-of-tune singing – not so much because I have a great ear – but more because I know what "in-tune" sounds like, and nothing else matches up.

It is the same with our **worship**. In-tune worship is not about flash and dazzle, musicianship and expertise, technological brilliance, or even theological depth of knowledge. All of that is good, but in-tune worship happens when every creature engaged is focused on our Lord.

In 2 Chronicles 5, we find the story of Solomon bringing the ark back to the Temple. As part of the proceedings, a large orchestra accompanied a huge choir as they praised the God of heaven. God's glory so filled the Temple, in the form of a cloud, that the priests could not continue their ministry. God's glory did not fill the Temple because of the size, expertise, or volume of the music and musicians. God's glory filled the Temple because, as verse 13 states, "The trumpeters and singers joined in unison, as with one voice." That's in-tune worship!

God's unequalled greatness deserves our unhindered worship. So, in our worship of the Lord, let's keep Him foremost, above any distraction and beyond any triviality. Let us praise Him according to His excellent greatness. Let every creature that has breath praise the Lord!
