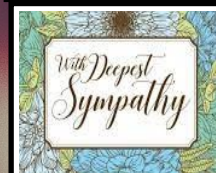

Please take some of the cards to mail to your friends and neighbors to invite them to our Christmas programs

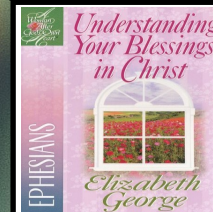
