


NEXT

10th - 12th Grade - Orange




What about MEALS?

Bogg Springs will supply 3 meals a day except on Monday (supper only) and Friday (grab & go breakfast only). You can bring snacks, but make sure you can seal them tightly. You may also bring drinks. We will have coolers of water, one for the boys, and one for the girls. We will also stop to eat lunch on Monday at McDonald's in Glenwood, and we will do the same on Friday for Breakfast as we return home.

Will I need money at camp?

You will need money to purchase items at the camp concession stand. Also, last year they sold Bogg Springs T-shirts at the concession stand, if you would like to purchase one. (A NEXT CAMP t-shirt will be provided as part of your registration)Bogg Doggs will be available after services each night for \$2.



What do we wear at camp?

Modest apparel is the general expectation. But to elaborate for some... Shorts, mid-thigh or end of finger tips (unless you have really short arms), and a t-shirt are what most will wear during most of the day.You may want to bring some "old clothes" that you don't mind getting ruined for recreation time. Some like to "clean up" and "dress up" for evening services but it is not required. You must wear some kind of shoes when you are outside. Bogg Springs has lots of sharp rocks and, if I'm not mistaken, foot injuries are the #1 nurse's station problem at camp.

Boys and girls must "cover up" when going to and from the pool.Don't be a distraction and remember to honor Christ.



Bogg Springs will provide a bunk and mattress, toilet, sink and shower. You will pretty much need to bring everything else. Including, but not limited to, bedding (for twin size mattress), towels, wash cloths, toiletries, etc. And oh yes, DON'T FORGET YOUR BIBLE!
